A new test determines if you may have contracted COVID-19 in the past. Here are some common questions and answers regarding this test.

How does this test differ from prior COVID-19 tests?

This test **ONLY** confirms you had contact with a sick person or were sick yourself with COVID-19 greater than two weeks ago.

Why is this test helpful?

It helps agencies know how many people were exposed to or infected by the COVID-19 virus.

Do I have to have the test if I don't want to?

No, and there are limitations. This test does not:

- Protect you from getting sick.
- Determine if you are currently sick with COVID-19.
- Stop you from spreading COVID-19 to others.
- Replace social distancing, cough and hand hygiene, and keeping away from those who are vulnerable to the disease.
- Have ample studies to show its accuracy.

What does it mean if I test positive?

You were likely exposed, or infected with, the COVID-19 virus over two weeks ago.

What does it mean if I test negative?

You likely were not exposed, or infected with, the COVID-19 virus over two weeks ago.
